## NEBRASKA HIGH SCHOOL BOWLING FEDERATION RULES

To represent a high school in interscholastic competition, a student must abide by eligibility rules of the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation.

If you do not understand a summary of these rules listed below or you need an explanation of other requirements consult the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation.

1. Student must be an undergraduate.
2. Student must be enrolled in at least 20 hours per week, attend regularly, and maintaining a "C" grade average with no failing grades.
3. After student's initial enrollment in grade nine, he/she shall be ineligible after eight semesters of school attendance.
4. Student must have been enrolled in school (public or private) or a home school program the immediate preceding semester.
5. All participants are required to, upon request, present school records indicating acceptable eligibility credit hours for the immediate preceding semester, current enrollment, and eligibility to compete in an extracurricular activity in accordance with school policy.
6. Once the season of a sport begins, a student shall compete only in athletic contests/meets in that sport, which are scheduled by his/her school or coach. Any other competition will render the student ineligible for the remainder of the season in that sport. The season of sport begins with the first date of practice as permitted by Nebraska High School Bowling Federation.
7. A student shall not participate in a contest under an assumed name.
8. A student must maintain his/her amateur status.
9. A student who transfers from one high school to another within the same district without an accompanying change of domicile by his/her parents becomes ineligible for interscholastic varsity competition for ninety school days.
- 10. Where local standards exist for the above rules, the local school rules will take precedence.**

### Eligibility Determinations

The Nebraska High School Bowling Federation Board of Directors shall determine eligibility.

### Athletic Information

If the student, parents, coach, bowling proprietors, or athletic trainer feel that the student is not in good physical condition, participation will not be permitted.

In case of injury received either in practice or in a game, the bowling centers will endeavor to furnish temporary first aid only. The bowling center cannot perform or be held responsible for any medical attention, which might be required, nor can it assume or be liable for loss or damage suffered by reason of injuries to pupils. If, in case of injury the parent or the family physician cannot be located, the coach is authorized to use their best judgment in obtaining competent medical care and service. Parents are obligated to pay for professional medical and/or related services; the coaches, bowling centers, or school shall not be liable for the payment of such services.

### Caution:

Participation in these activities involves the potential for injury, which is inherent in all sports. Even with the best coaching, use of the most advanced protective equipment and strict observance of rules, injuries are still a possibility. On rare occasions these injuries can be so severe as to result in total disability, paralysis, or even death.

### Due Process for Co-curricular Activities

Students may be suspended by the Coach, Bowling proprietor or his/her designee from practices or participation in interscholastic competition or participation in co-curricular activities for violation of rules and standards of behavior adopted by the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation.

If a participant, the students, parents or guardian are not satisfied with the determination by the activity sponsor or coach, a hearing may be requested. However, the student will remain suspended from activity pending the outcome of the hearing.

**NEBRASKA HIGH SCHOOL BOWLING FEDERATION MINIMUM STANDARDS OF CONDUCT LOCAL  
SCHOOL DISTRICT REQUIREMENTS MAY VARY AND WILL TAKE PRECEDENCE**

Pupils participate of their own accord and with their parent's knowledge and consent.

The following conduct shall constitute grounds for suspension from practices, participation in competition or other participation in on going activities. When such conduct occurs on school grounds, or during an educational function or event off school grounds or off school grounds during the season of the bowling activity.

1. Willfully disobeying any reasonable written or oral request of a school staff member or the voicing of disrespect of those in authority, (Coaches, Asst Coaches or Bowling Center staff).
2. The use of violence, force, coercion, threat, intimidation or similar conduct in a manner that constitutes a substantial interference with school purposes.
3. Sexually assaulting or attempting to sexually assault any student, school employee, or any coaching staff or bowling center staff.
4. Willfully causing or attempting to cause substantial damage to private or school property, stealing or attempting to steal private or school property of small value.
5. Causing or attempting to cause physical injury to a bowling center employee, coaching staff or to any student.
6. Threatening or intimidating any student for the purpose of, or with the intent of obtaining money or anything of value from such student.
7. Knowingly possessing, handling or transmitting any object or material that is ordinarily or generally considered a weapon.
8. Engaging in the selling, using, possession or dispensing of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, narcotics, drugs (other than those prescribed by a physician), controlled substances, inhalant, or being under the influence of any of the above, or possession of drug paraphernalia.
9. Failure to report for the activity at the beginning of each session; reporting for one activity may count as reporting on time if there is a change in activity within the season approved by the coach or supervisor.
10. Failure to participate in regularly scheduled classes on the day of an athletic/activity event.
11. Failure to attend all scheduled practices and meetings. If circumstances arise to prevent the participant's attendance, the coach will determine the validity of the reason. Every reasonable effort should be made to notify the coach or supervisor prior to all missed practices, meetings or competitions.
12. Truancy or failure to attend assigned classes or activities.
13. Tardiness to school assigned classes or assigned activities.
14. The use of language either verbal or physical, which is profane or abusive to student's coaches or staff members.
15. Public indecency as defined in Nebraska statutes
16. Good sportsmanship shall be observed during practice sessions and contests.
17. Repeated violation of any of the rules adopted by the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation, the school district or the school attending.
18. Engaging in any other unlawful activity as determined by the United States or the State of Nebraska.
19. Dressing in a manner wherein such dress is dangerous to the student's health and safety or to the health and safety of others or is distractive or indecent or the extent that it interferes with the learning and teaching process.
20. All reasonable rules or regulations adopted by the coach or supervisor of a co-curricular activity shall be followed provided that participants shall be notified by the coach or Bowling Centers of such rules and regulations by written handouts, posting on bulletin boards, or verbal announcements prior to competition.
21. Failure to comply with any rule established by the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation, including but not limited to, rules related to eligibility.
22. Uniform shirts are the property of the Nebraska High School Bowling Federation, and WILL be turned in the last night of formal competition. Uniform shirts will be worn during all competitions, (District matches and Tournaments). Bowlers will not be allowed in the bowling area if they are not in uniform, till the uniform shirts come in each athlete will be allowed to wear respectable shirts or T-shirts at the coaches' discretion.
23. Students may be required to purchase their own equipment.
24. Students will be responsible for their own transportation to and from all matches. In the event an out of town tournament, they will be responsible for their own transportation, meals and lodging.
25. Spectators are not permitted in the bowler's area and respectable fan behavior is expected. Irresponsible behavior as determined by the coaches' can result in the removal of the spectator.
26. Allow the coaches to do their job. If the Coach is having difficulty getting your athlete on track, the Coach will ask for assistance. Coach's decisions are final and binding.
27. The Nebraska High School Bowling Federation Board of Directors will decide rules not covered herein.

**PARENT OR GUARDIAN’S CONSENT RECORD FOR PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES**

I/we realize that participation involves the potential, which is inherent in all sports. I/we acknowledge that even with the best coaching, use of the most advanced protective equipment and strict observance of rules, injuries are still a possibility. On rare occasions these injuries can be severe as to result in total disability, paralysis, or even death.

I/we have read the rules of eligibility pertaining to activities participation and acknowledge and understand the purpose and content thereof, including the parent domicile, student transfer and eligibility crediting rules.

I/we acknowledge that parents are obligated to pay for professional medical and/or related services; the Bowling Centers or Coaches shall not be liable for payment of such services.

I/we acknowledge that insurance coverage is recommended for all participants at the parent’s expense.

I/we acknowledge that all activity participants are required to have on school records a minimum of acceptable credit hours for the immediate preceding semester, must currently be considered enrolled and eligible to compete in an extracurricular activity, in accordance with local school policy.

I/we understand the activity may be conducted at a location other than the student’s school of attendance. In all instances the school, coaches, Nebraska High School Bowling Federation, or Bowling Centers **WILL NOT** provide transportation between the school of attendance and the site of competition.

I/we also understand transportation to the site is the sole responsibility of the bowler and/or parent/guardian, and may involve transportation by a private vehicle driven by others. In the event of out of town tournament, transportation, meals and lodging is the sole responsibility of the student, parent/guardian.

I/we give our permission for academic information including grade point average, class rank and any academic awards/recognition received by the athlete to be released for the purpose of verifying grade eligibility. The information will also be used to recognize excellence in both athletics and academics. This information will be used by newspapers, awards banquets, assemblies or all state awards.
